

### Dear Home,

As you will be aware, Mrs Jones will be leaving us at the end of term and we are therefore restructuring her roles and responsibilities within our leadership team.

### The changes in leadership will be as follows:

Mrs Hill will be seconded into the Deputy Head role for 12 months to develop this as part of her portfolio and support the school's next journey. Mrs Hill has been a teacher at Oakmeadow for many years, she has expertise in many curriculum areas and a wide understanding of the whole school needs. She is the English Manager across the whole school and also oversees the quality of education alongside myself as Head. I feel very privileged that as a school, we have such a strong team that we can develop internally. We will move into January 2020 with Mrs Hill as the Deputy Head, Mrs Morris will remain Assistant Head over Key Stage 2 and she is also the school Special Needs Coordinator. Ms Taylor will remain as Assistant Head over Reception and KS1 and is also in charge of maths across the whole school. Mrs Williamson, as some of you will know, is the teacher in charge of Nursery and in addition leads in early reading and phonics, Mrs Griffiths who is curriculum manager and Mr Ostermeyer who oversees computing and PE/Sport. Also within school our experienced teachers lead and drive their curriculum initiatives and every teacher pays a huge part in whole school development.

Mrs Jones leaves a huge gap in our school both in regard to her role and within our hearts, however we have been planning ahead for this and we are very prepared with all the jobs and tasks to ensure the school continues to run smoothly. We have tried hard to minimise the impact that this will have on the children and therefore, her current teaching responsibilities will be taken up by Ms Taylor.

With this in mind, we have appointed a new teacher to take over Butterflies Class. We have been lucky enough to appoint a fabulous teacher who has needed to move to the area recently.

We hope this information is useful.

We now head into our CHRISTMAS period (that came quickly!!!), it is a busy time but we are really looking forward to our Christmas productions. Can I remind you that dates are out- please put them in your diary and we look forward to seeing you all there. In addition we have the whole school visit to the panto to look forward to!!
