The School Admissions Team is focused on the allocation of Primary School places, on 16 April 2020, and efforts are focussed on meeting that mandatory date.

Please see attached information received from the Local Authority in the event of an appeal for a school placement.

"In the current emergency situation of the Covid-19, we enter unchartered territory. Whilst the Local Authority recognise that parents will be anxious for their appeal to be heard, we must all be mindful of the risk the standard appeals procedure would present to parents, children, appeal panel members (who are all volunteers), and school and admission authority representatives. We are currently awaiting information from the Department for Education about the scheduling of appeals, which will give an indication of the timeframe for such hearings. Once we have confirmation of this, Legal and Democratic Services will contact parents regarding the appeal."
