Dear Parents and Carers,

After half term, we are pleased to offer additional swimming sessions to Year 5 which will be taking place at Shrewsbury School. We have extended our curriculum offer beyond what we normally offer in Y3 so that we can promote our children meeting the end of key stage swimming attainment targets of:

- Swimming competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of **at least** 25 metres
- Using a range of strokes effectively, for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke.
- Performing safe self-rescue in different water based situations

In the current climate, we may not be able to take the children on many trips or events this term, however, in accordance with guidance and advice offered by the DfE, Swim England and the Association for Physical Education (AfPE), as well as via thorough research and risk assessment procedures through liaison with both the coach company and the provider, we will be able to run this curriculum offer safely.

To comply with the guidance, it has been agreed between all parties involved (Oakmeadow, Shrewsbury School and Minsterley Motors) that the swimming sessions will follow the following structure:

- Y5 as a cohort bubble will attend in two different blocks of 3 weeks on a Monday, with Owls attending for the first 3 weeks beginning Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> November followed by Badgers beginning Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November.
- On the day of their swimming session, children will be required to come to school with their swimming shorts/costumes underneath their school uniform.
- All children will sanitise their hands upon leaving school and before embarking onto the coach.
- Children will sit apart on the coach according to social distancing measures where possible. Children will sanitise their hands upon leaving the coach using sanitiser provided by school.
- Upon arriving at Shrewsbury School, children will follow a one-way system to poolside where they will remove their uniform ready for swimming.
- Following the end of swimming sessions, children will change into their uniform in the changing rooms, overseen by 2 members of staff, and will then sanitise their hands upon leaving Shrewsbury School before getting back onto the coach.

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Humility

- Children will re-sanitise their hands upon leaving the coach back at the Beeches Gate before reentering school.
- Wet towels and swimwear will be stored in lockers and will need to be taken home with the children on the same day.
