Dear Parents/Carers

We are planning to take the children in Bumblebees and Grasshoppers on a visit to Park Hall Farm outside Oswestry on Friday 10th May 2019. This will build on the work we are covering in our 'Step into Spring' topic and support the 'Understanding the World' aspect of Early Years.

Park Hall have kindly reduced the price as much as possible for us, but it will still cost £12.50 per child. We appreciate that this is a considerable amount of money, and to help spread the cost, have set up the option to pay in instalments between now and the visit. Payment is to be made via School Money and you will be sent a link via text message and email to enable you to do so. You will also be asked to give consent for your child to attend the trip via school money when making payment. Please ensure you have ticked the consent box. All emergency contact details and medical information will be taken from our school system so please make sure all your details and your child's medical information is up to date. If you need to make any changes please contact the school office.

We know from experience that Park Hall Farm offers value for money and the children will love the experience. They were winners of the National Farm Park for Education 2018. The day will include; pony grooming, rabbit petting, leading the heavy horses, tractor ride, lamb feeding, milking not forgetting the pig racing! The children will have a hands –on opportunity to learn about the habitats, eating regimes and care of animals.

The children will need to wear their school uniform tops and jumpers with tracksuit bottoms/joggers and wellies for their bottom half and a waterproof coat appropriate for the weather. They will also need a packed lunch (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). A packed lunch can be provided for children in FS2 as they are entitled to a school meal under the Government's Universal Free School Meals scheme.
