# What is Eclipse?

ECLIPSE is a service that supports bereaved children

We are a service based in Shrewsbury that seeks to support children and young people, aged 5-18, through the grieving process. Some facts;

- Every 22 minutes a child in Britain is bereaved of a parent—over 24,000 children this year.
- Approximately 1 in 25 children and young people have experienced a bereavement of a parent or sibling —that is about 1 in every classroom!
- Around 480,000 children under the age of 18 in Britain have experienced the death of a parent or sibling.

Childhood bereavement is associated with;

- Health problems
- Mental health problems
- Low self esteem
- Poor school performance
- School exclusion
- Youth offending
- Drug Use
- Higher rate of teenage pregnancy

Eclipse Shrewsbury has 10 volunteers. All give time to be a part of this valuable work with children who are vulnerable.

# What services do Eclipse offer?

### Session Work

We aim to meet with children regularly to work through the myriad of emotions that come with grief, including the understanding and management of anger. We offer as many sessions as the child requires.

# Memory Books



A memory book provides a gentle tool to facilitate the grieving process. We can record memories of the times spent with the person who died, include photos and other memorabilia. Children are

encouraged to personalise the book and also add to them at home.

# Special Occasions

Sometimes it is appropriate to mark occasions, such as anniversaries, birthdays. Children can do this in many ways: we facilitate things like making memory jars, letting off special

balloons, making cards, lighting candles and other interesting ways appropriate to the age of the child.

# Why would a child need ECLIPSE?

It may help to know that when something sad happens, children and young people often:

- Avoid feelings
- \* Push feelings away
- Hide their feelings
- \* Disguise their feelings
- Deny their feelings
- Covér their feelings

We can assist children in working with these feelings safely as they grieve.

It is never too soon or too late to help a bereaved child.

We can be involved in the immediate aftermath of a bereavement, or a child may be referred years after the loss occurs.

We are able to offer support to all children who are bereaved we visit them in school hours at school for 40-60 minute sessions.

We can also help parents/carers/professionals to support under 5s who have been bereaved.

Helping Children to Cope;

- Asking
- Acknowledging
- Empowering

These services are all free of charge. We will work with your school to help children who have been bereaved.
