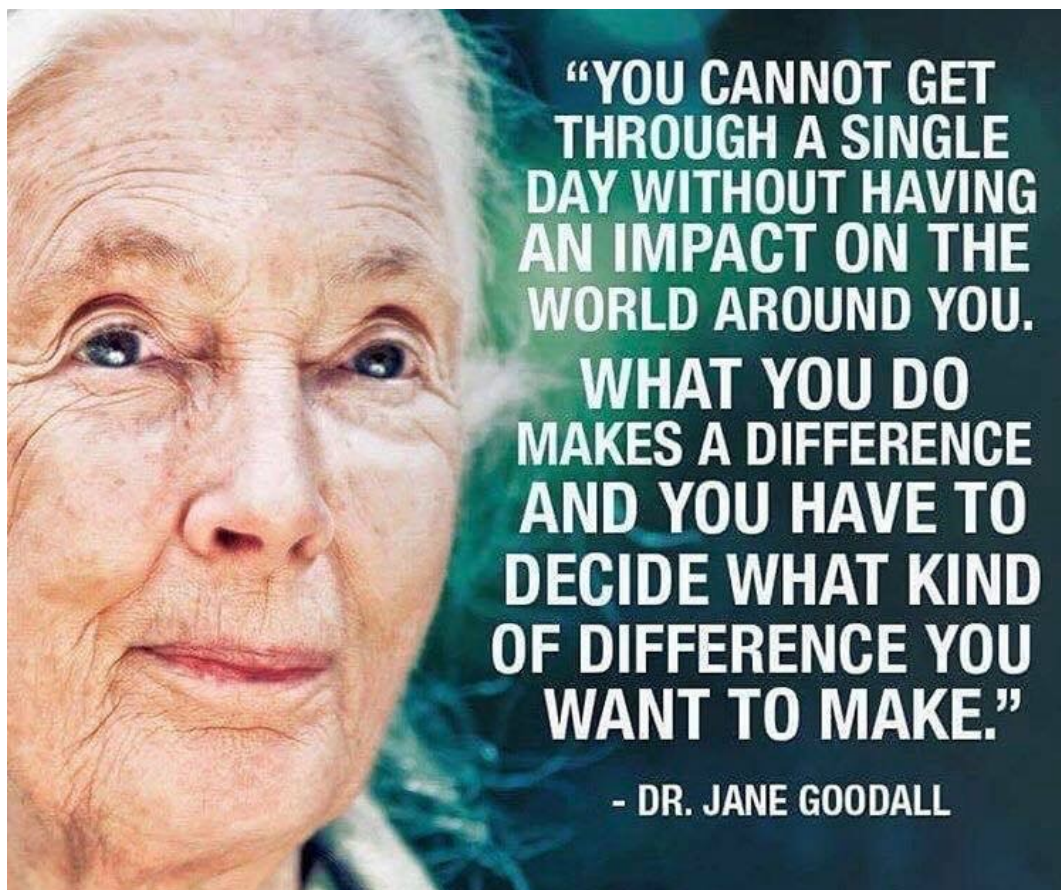


Dear Home,

Ladybirds Nursery at Oakmeadow School has places for 2, 3 & 4 year olds. 24U, funded and paid places are available. We take great pride in our daily provision, our fabulous (large) outdoor area and a real commitment and focus on outdoor learning, including a trained forest school teacher and our own forest area.

We are open Monday – Friday from 7.50am – 5.30pm and offer the following sessions during term time:

Breakfast club from 7.50 - 9am
Morning learning session 9 - 11.30am
Lunch session 11.30 - 12.30pm
Afternoon learning session 12.30 - 3pm
After school care from 3 - 5.30pm

Choose sessions at different points throughout the day and use your *funded hours flexibly*. The new 30 hours of funding available to qualifying parents of 3 & 4 year olds can be used in any of the above sessions.
