Important: Update Your Child's Details on Arbor

Thank you for your feedback about communication. To make things simpler and more accurate, we are asking all parents to **update their child/ren's details on the Arbor app**.

From **Monday 8th September**, we will use Arbor as our main source of information, including:

- Permissions for walking home (Year 5/6 only), along with other permissions
- Dietary and medical information
- Key contacts

Updating Arbor helps us:

- Avoid sending duplicate Microsoft forms
- Reduce errors from manual input

Quick steps to update:

- 1. Log in to the Arbor app (or via a web browser).
- 2. Select your child's profile.
- 3. Review and update Medical, Dietary, Permissions, and Contacts.
- 4. Save any changes.


